DINING ROOM

Dining Room Server

Help serve the daily meal in St. Anthony Dining Room. Place food on trays in the serving line, deliver trays to seniors, families and people with disabilities, bus dishes, clean tables, assist in food preparation, and get to know our guests. *EVERY DAY 10:00a.m.– 2:00 p.m.*

SOCIAL WORK CENTER

Information Table Volunteer

Staff an information table in the Dining Room during the daily meal. Provide information and referrals for housing, employment, medical services, etc. to guests. *Everyday 10:00 am– 2:00pm*

DMV Assistant

Assist SWC staff in exchanging SAF DMV voucher for SAF check so that clients may apply for California ID. Assist staff with identity verification, voucher collection and dispersing checks, assuring that clients complete the application process.

WEDNESDAYS, 1:30-3:30 at DMV at Fell and Baker Streets in San Francisco

Food Pantry Organizer

Help the SWC staff by organizing & shelving food pantry donations. This position requires some lifting and the ability to work independently. *Weekday times as needed.*

Food Pantry Monitor

Assist enrolled food pantry clients during their visit to the Pantry. This position requires good interpersonal skills, patience, and good judgment. *Weekday hours as needed.*

LEARNING CENTER/ EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

Basic Education Tutor

Help teach basic education & study skills in a study hall environment at our Father Alfred Center.

Weekday evenings as needed.

Job Coach

Do you have a background in teaching basic job search skills?
