**St. Anthony's Serves its 46 Millionth Meal
With Mayor London Breed**

SAN FRANCISCO (April 16, 2021) – St. Anthony's will serve its 46 Millionth Meal on **Friday, April 16, 2021**. Mayor London Breed will join us to commemorate this milestone starting at 11:30 AM.

"A lot has changed in the last year, but we are proud to say that we are still serving San Francisco," said CEO Nils Behnke.

In March 2020, St. Anthony's moved its Dining Room and other essential services outdoors to comply with COVID-19 safety protocols. Since then, all meals have been served to-go, with the option to eat at socially-distanced tables outside. In this way, we were able to continue our service uninterrupted, even as demand grew. Last year, we served 2,800 freshly prepared meals a day, reaching a peak of 3,800 meals in one day at the height of the pandemic.

We are looking forward to re-opening our Dining Room as soon as it is safely possible to do so. In the meantime, St. Anthony's invites all interested press to join us as we celebrate our 46 Millionth Meal. We take this moment to appreciate our community, while resolving to work towards an equitable future, in which the world's abundant resources are made available to all.
