Thanks to your steadfast support of St. Anthony's in 2023, I'm proud to share the highlights that were made possible this past year. We are especially grateful to our **Leadership Council**, whose generous support of nearly **\$6.3** million in gifts of **\$10,000** and more since its inception helped to provide the extra margin of excellence that our innovative services require to uplift St. Anthony's guests on their journeys to more stable lives. We continue our commitment to the city and to making positive change happen.

LEADING THE WAY THROUGH LEADERSHIP

- In 2024, we will welcome a new **Chief Executive Officer**. The Board of Directors and Search Committee have an excellent pool of candidates under consideration and hope to make an announcement in early March.
- We welcomed new Board Chair, Maija Muncy, who in addition to having been St. Anthony's Vice Chair, Secretary and Development Committee Chair, has served as Chair of the Board of Drew School and the San Francisco Education Fund. Our former esteemed Board Chair, Tim Dunn, has been appointed Emeritus Board Chair.
- Muncy announced the appointment of a new Board member, Fr. Tom Nairn, former provincial minister of the Sacred Heart Province of Franciscans from 2017 to 2023, who served nine years as Senior Director of Ethics and Theology at the Catholic Health Association of the United States.
- The Board of Directors and the new CEO, along with the senior staff of St. Anthony's, will begin the strategic planning process in preparation for St. Anthony's 75th Anniversary in 2025.

OPPORTUNITIES: LEADING BY EXAMPLE

- Thanks to the efforts of our Board and staff, and with the support of McKinsey & Co., #StartSmall, and the Kaplan Family Trust, St. Anthony's Women's & Children's Services are expanding wellness, parenting and therapeutic play, counseling, and employment training to a growing number of families for whom temporary shelter must be a fully-supported pathway to stability.
- St. Anthony's Medical Clinic, with the help of the new Welcome Center that opened in September, is supporting eligible guests with annual Medi-Cal re-enrollment to ensure they can continue to receive needed treatment and healing, allowing us to case manage each guest. It has also instituted drop-in hours to accommodate guests who seek treatment through the Welcome Center
- And, our unique Companionship Model of Care, under the auspices of our Medical Clinic, is growing its multi-year support of Father Alfred Center graduates beyond graduation with planned sober living options, digital literacy through our Tech Lab, and career development as they continue their transformational journeys to renewal and stability.

We continue to be grateful that your support allows us to do more with less as prices have risen for essentials. It is this commitment to our mission of creating a society where all persons can flourish, combined with our foundational Franciscan values, that sustains us and enables us to make real transformative change for our neighbors experiencing homelessness, substance use disorder, and behavioral health challenges. We look forward to our continued partnership, as we explore new ways to flourish in 2024.

- The Dining Room served 1,678 meals daily, for over 612,339 meals in 2023 (+3% increase)
- 173,000+ pieces of free new and gently-used clothing were distributed to 7,825 adults and children (+12% increase)
- 166 resident guests spent 15,402 nights at Father Alfred Center (+44% increase)
- 1,406 laundry users washed and dried
 8,164 loads (+43% increase)
- More than 75 former guests with lived experience make up 28% of St. Anthony's staff

- 2,150+ individuals and families, many undocumented and housing challenged, received quality care and preventative services through 13,285 Medical Clinic visits (+21% increase)
- 5,161 Resource Center visits by 1,691 guests helped them access essential services (+26% increase)
- 1,688 Hygiene Hub shower guests took 9,613 total showers (+6% increase)



Center was introduced outside on Golden Gate Avenue, with an expert team of Guest Navigators to provide a no-barrier resource center to help guests assess and prioritize needs, and connect to St. Anthony's resources and other community services.



Our **Tenderloin Tech Lab**, which supports our guests in achieving digital literacy, was the grateful recipient of a \$20,000 gift from AT&T, to upgrade equipment, enhance educational offerings, and improve facilities.



St. Ignatius Parish volunteers collected more than 160 bags of clothes for our Free Clothing Program. This generous gift will brighten the lives of struggling families we serve every day.
